Town Centre Paving Upgrade

The 2nd and final stage of the Waiuku town centre paving upgrade is nearly complete. I have been asked by the contractors and Auckland Transport to do a walk over the job next week to advise them of any issues. If you have any pavers you have noticed are sitting a little proud or high or any other issues re the laying please let me know so I can make sure it gets noted and sorted before they sign off the job.

It has been agreed that the funds collected from the sale of the old pavers be put to the repair of the 3 damaged flagtrax poles and a new set of flags for the town.

This brings me to an issue with the poles we have our flagtrax on. We have noticed that there are a couple of poles that have been hit by delivery

trucks. The pole outside Osbornes by the loading bay has been hit a number of times. These tracks aren't cheap to repair so if you see a truck hit them can you please take the number plate and description of the truck so we can ask them to repair it. This cost should not fall on the Waiuku Business Association to repair.

Tamakae Wharf Update

We have been advised that the completion date for the wharf hard edging has been pushed out to the 27th April however we have had an assurance from Council staff and contractors that the job will be completed and the site cleaned in time for the Steel n Wheels Festival.
